Mother's Day Candles

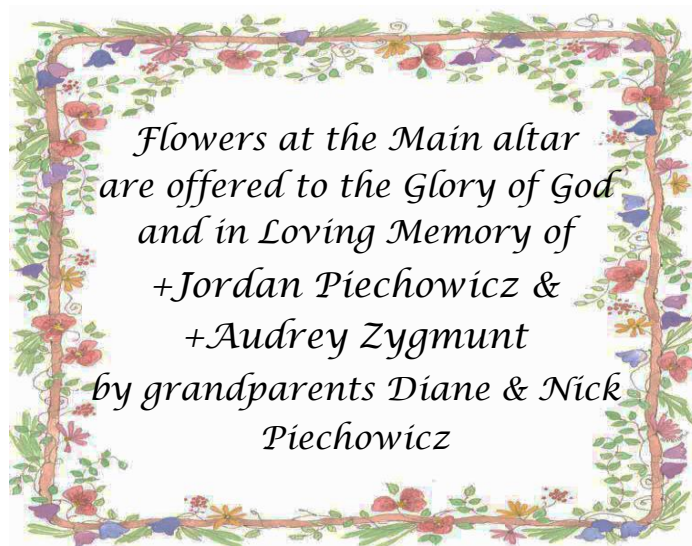
