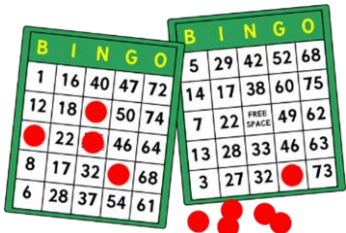

Thursdays (11:30 AM): Oct 23 / Oct 30

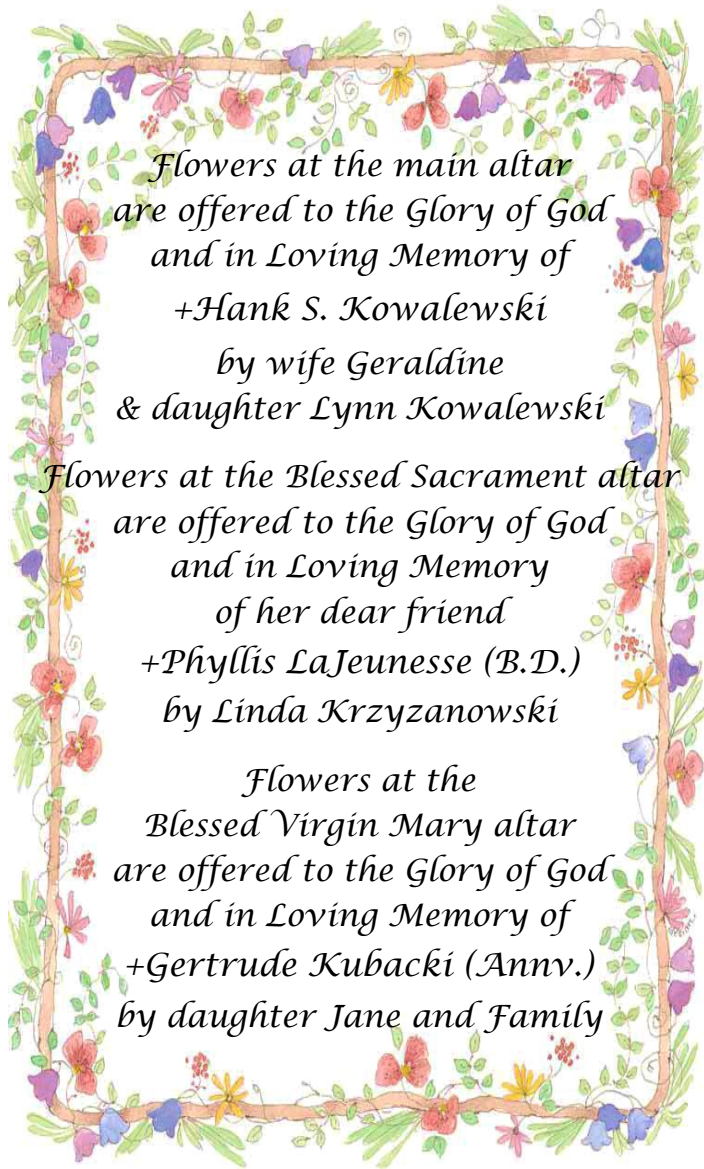
All Souls' Day Remembrances
