


Come Celebrate with the Saints!

The feast of the Conversion of St. Paul is celebrated on Monday, January 26 this year. St. Paul (formerly Saul) was one of the most zealous Jewish persecutors of the early Christian church and its followers. He was responsible for the deaths of thousands! After being knocked off of his horse and blinded by the Lord, he was led into Damascus where he found Ananias, who was instructed to lay hands on him and restore his sight. After his miraculous conversion, “the scales were lifted from his eyes.”

He was then one of the most ardent disciples of Jesus, spreading the teachings and life of Jesus around the Mediterranean Sea and its countries. He also penned most of the New Testament “letters” to the churches he had established there. He is known as the “Apostle to the Gentiles.” Why not come and honor his legacy by coming to Mass at 9 AM on Monday, January 26?

(P.S. – are you aware that the cathedral has a statue of St. Paul’s conversion in the Eucharistic chapel?)
