UPDATE – Fish Fry

Thank you to everyone who has so far stepped forward to help with our monthly fish fry. It is an important fundraiser for us, and it is quite popular. Your help is appreciated!

We're now down to four tasks that we still need help with:

- Cook noodles: Boil noodles according to directions, and store for making salad. Wednesday, about 2¼ hours.
- Bake cakes: Simply assemble ingredients from a mix and bake! Wednesday, about 3½ hours.
- Kitchen setup: Before the fish fry, we need cardboard cut and set out to catch drips, sauce and dip prepared, and dishes and mixes pulled out to be ready to use. Friday before the fish fry, about 2 hours.
- Kitchen cleanup: Send dishes through the dishwasher and put them away, clean countertops, remove the cardboard, and just make sure everything is cleaned up. After the fish fry, for about 1½ hours.

With more people working on each job, they can get done faster as well. Please consider whether you can spare the time to help, as many hands make light work!

Remember: helping with the fish fry is helping your church.

Come Celebrate with the Saints!

The feast of the Conversion of St. Paul is celebrated on Monday, January 26 this year. St. Paul (formerly Saul) was one of the most zealous Jewish persecutors of the early Christian church and its followers. He was responsible for the deaths of thousands! After being knocked off of his horse and blinded by the Lord, he was led into Damascus where he found Ananias, who was instructed to lay hands on him and restore his sight. After his miraculous conversion, “the scales were lifted from his eyes.”

He was then one of the most ardent disciples of Jesus, spreading the teachings and life of Jesus around the Mediterranean Sea and its countries. He also penned most of the New Testament “letters” to the churches he had established there. He is known as the “Apostle to the Gentiles.” Why not come and honor his legacy by coming to Mass at 9 AM on Monday, January 26?
