## UPDATE – Fish Fry

Thank you to everyone who has so far stepped forward to help with our monthly fish fry. It is an important fundraiser for us, and it is quite popular. Your help is appreciated!

We're now down to three tasks that we still need help with:

- Cook noodles: Boil noodles according to directions, and store for making salad. Wednesday, about 2¼ hours.
- Bake cakes: Simply assemble ingredients from a mix and bake! Wednesday, about 3½ hours (including baking time).
- Kitchen cleanup: Send dishes through the dishwasher and put them away, clean countertops, remove the cardboard, and just make sure everything is cleaned up. After the fish fry, for about 1½ hours.

With more people working on each job, they can get done faster as well. Please consider whether you can spare the time to help, as many hands make light work!
